BROOKS ANNOUNCES NEW ALLEGIANT AIR NON-STOP SERVICE TO ORLANDO/SANFORD

More Options, More Seats, More Affordability for ROC Travelers

Monroe County Executive **Maggie Brooks** today announced that Allegiant Air, who recently launched service from the Greater Rochester International Airport (ROC) beginning October 9, 2015 to Ft. Lauderdale (FLL), Florida, will also begin new non-stop service from ROC to the Orlando Sanford International Airport (SFB) beginning November 13, 2015.

"Monroe County is thrilled that Allegiant is already expanding in Rochester with new non-stop service from ROC to Orlando Sanford International Airport," said **Brooks**. "Orlando is the number one destination for Rochester area travelers and the addition of this non-stop service means more seats, options and affordable air travel opportunities for area passengers."

In 2014, 207 passengers traveled daily between ROC and Orlando International Airport (MCO), Florida. Allegiant plans to use an MD-80 or Airbus A320 aircraft for the new Orlando/Sanford (SFB) service twice weekly, which means approximately 340 more seats per week for area travelers to Orlando.

Focusing on low-cost leisure travel, Allegiant provides customers with low base fares nearly half of the cost of the average domestic round-trip fare. Their innovative business model has allowed the company to grow from one aircraft and one route just over a decade ago, to providing convenient, affordable service in over 100 communities nationwide.
