ROC AIRPORT SHUTTLE LOT (YELLOW LOT) TO CLOSE FOR SURFACE REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT

Rochester, NY – Beginning Monday, October 3, 2022, the Shuttle Lot (Yellow Lot) at the Frederick Douglass Greater Rochester International Airport will be closed to new customer vehicle parking for an undetermined period of time for a surface repair and replacement project. All customers with cars currently parked in the Yellow Lot will be able to exit upon their return to Rochester. Crews will begin work on the Yellow Lot once all vehicles have been removed.

The Economy Shuttle Lot (Red Lot), located on the northeast corner of Brooks Avenue and Buell Road across from the ROC Airport, will temporarily reopen to accommodate for the temporary closure of the Yellow Lot. Customers will be able to park in the Red Lot for \$8/day, which is the same price as the Yellow Lot. The parking detour will be posted and signs will direct all vehicles to available parking lots at the ROC Airport campus.

Current Parking Options at the Frederick Douglass Greater Rochester International Airport:

- Long Term Parking (Orange Lot – Covered Garage) - \$16/day for Level 1 and Level 2; \$12/day for the roof
- Weekly Parking (Green Lot) - \$12/day; \$72 max/week
- Economy Shuttle Lot (Red Lot) - \$8/day
- Hourly Parking (Purple Lot) - \$2 for the first hour, \$1 each additional half hour; \$24 max/day

The Yellow Lot will reopen to customer parking upon project completion. The Red Lot will close to new customer parking when the Yellow Lot reopens. All customers parked in the Red Lot at the time will be able to access their vehicle and exit upon returning to Rochester.

As always, passengers are encouraged to arrive at the Airport at least 90 minutes prior to their departure times and to follow the detour signage during this period.
